From tiny to gigantic! Sculpt with plaster, plasticine, papier maché, and clay to create 3D works of art. Develop your own design on our 3D printer!

Chickadees

Celebrate New Brunswick’s beautiful landscape and creatures! Animal sculptures, masks, maquettes, and more with sketching along the Green.
